She has also achieved a UD and a CD on 2 Norwegian Elkhounds, and a CD with Dog World Award scores on a Dalmatian and an Australian Shepherd. Lori has instructed all levels of classes for Oakland Dog Training Club for 11 years, and has had the privilege of contributing to the advanced level success of students with some "non-traditional" obedience breeds, such as a Lhasa Apso, several St. Bernards, a Pharaoh Hound, and a number of Siberian Huskies. She continues to enjoy teaching classes and doing private lessons once each month at ODTTC, and in her new home at Fall River Mills, CA. Lori is an AKC judge for Novice, and a columnist for "Front and Finish".
