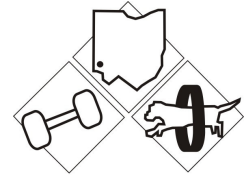

Obedience trials will be calculated as follows: Novice at 9 dogs/hour; Open at 8 dogs/hour; Utility at 7 dogs/hour. Saturday Obedience Trial max = 54 entries. Rally trials will be calculated at 22 dogs/hour. Both rally trials max = 88 entries.

All dogs listed with the AKC Canine Partners Program must list "All American" under breed of dog on the entry form.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS *** PLEASE READ ***

Send completed entry forms (include both front **and** back of the official AKC entry form) with correct fees to: Summer McCabe, 406 Victoria Drive, Trenton, OH 45067. Entry forms **MUST** be signed at bottom by owner or owner's duly authorized agent. Entries unsigned or mailed in without both front and back of the official AKC entry form will **NOT** be accepted. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Please fill out the entry legibly! Make checks or money orders payable to HDTC.

Receipt of entry confirmations will only be emailed. After closing, confirmation letters with armband numbers and judging program will be snail mailed.

We cannot guarantee on-time arrival of entries sent via Fed Ex or other overnight service. Be sure to check the signature waiver box on your mailing form. Also, we cannot guarantee your entry if you use an on-line service (ie: infdog.com). These services usually mail a couple days before the closing date.

The term "dog" means either dog or bitch.

Any exhibitor whose bitch has come in season, or any dog which has occurred an injury or passed on after the closing date may obtain a refund of his entry fee (less \$5.00 for AKC fees and administrative expenses per entry) upon presentation of a Veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary prior to the start of the trial. **NOTE:** There will not be any refunds of entries **AFTER** closing date except for above reason. No refunds on overpayments of \$6.00 or less.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

FROM I-75 NORTH OR SOUTH -

Take the Union Centre Blvd. exit—EXIT 19.

Turn West (right from southbound or left from northbound).

Travel on Union Centre Blvd. for 4.5 miles. Union Centre Blvd. will then turn into Symmes Road.

Continue on Symmes for another 2 miles.

Arrive at 2720-C Symmes Road - on right hand side. Hamilton Dog Training Club's facility is located inside the building on the left in the back.

NOTE: If you went over railroad tracks, you just missed the driveway.

FROM I-275 WEST OR EAST -

Take the Springdale exit, Ohio Route 4—EXIT 41.

Turn North (right from westbound or left from eastbound).

Travel on Ohio Route 4 for 2.2 miles.

Turn right onto By-Pass Route 4.

Travel 1.4 miles to Symmes Road. Turn left onto Symmes Road.

Travel 1.4 miles to 2720-C Symmes Road - on right hand side. Hamilton Dog Training Club's facility is located inside the building on the left in the back.

Rally - both days - Novice, Advanced (small to tall), Excellent (small to tall)

Obedience - both days - Novice, Open (small to tall), Utility (small to tall)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (CON'T)

The handler is solely responsible for having the dog at ringside when scheduled. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. Dogs need be at the trial only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after, unless required for further judging.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of HDTC, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made. HDTC will not be responsible for loss or damage to property while on show site.

No entry will be accepted which carries any conditions regarding its acceptance.

HDTC will not be responsible for errors made on entries. Please double check entry prior to sending. Owners are responsible for errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Unsigned checks and returned checks do not constitute payment of fees.

Recording Fees will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

There will be an AKC Service Fee of 3.00 and an AKC Recording Fee of \$0.50 per entry in the Obedience Trial. There will be an AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 per 1st entry in the Rally Trial, plus \$3.00 per all additional entries. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fee is collected on all classes the dog is entered in, excluding non-regular classes.

THERE IS ALSO A PHONE ON THE PREMISES FOR EMERGENCIES.

All dogs must be kept on leash or crated at all times, except as allowed in the Show Ring. NO FLEXI LEADS ALLOWED INSIDE SHOW SITE.

The ring surface is thick matting at HDTC's training facility.

The Show Site will open one hour prior to the start of the event, and will close one hour after the event. Limited overnight crating will be available. Crating will only be allowed in areas marked. Water is available at the Show Site. Please keep aisles clear.

Lunch will be available for purchase on Saturday & Sunday. There are fast-food restaurants near the Show Site.

PARKING—HDTC training facility is located in the back. There should be plenty of parking. Please do **NOT** block any garage doors.

A photographer will be on sight.

Move ups will be allowed for these trials. All move ups will run at the end of their class, jump height. Move ups must be received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

AGREEMENT

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Coodles (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
